SCHEDULE	All students, all staff, 5 days per week, regular school hours.	Hybrid of face-to-face & distance learning. Students attend school on campus 1 to 2 days per week.	Campuses closed. All students learning/working from home.
TEACHING & LEARNING	Standards-based instruction will occur utilizing traditional methods on campus, incorporating distance learning and online tools.	Standards-based instruction will be a combination of traditional methods and distance learning with the incorporation of online tools such as Google Classroom, Zoom, etc.	Standards-based instruction will occur 100% through distance learning techniques and the incorporation of online tools such as Google Classroom, Zoom, etc.
HEALTH & SAFETY	Face-to-face learning will include recommended safety precautions such as social distancing, personal protective equipment, handwashing/ hygiene practices, cleaning protocols and health monitoring to ensure the safety of students and staff.	Hybrid learning may include the safety precautions outlined in Plan A for on-campus instruction. Students are encouraged to practice hand-washing/ hygiene practices while at home and on campus.	Consideration for full closure of campuses is based on recommendations made by the state of California and/or the Stanislaus County Public Health Office.
ADDITIONAL DETAILS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Transportation will be provided in plans A and B for those outside the walking distance boundaries. Face coverings will be required for all bus riders.</li><li>• Food service will be available during all plans. When students are learning on campus, alternative spaces to eat and socialize will be established to minimize group size.</li><li>• All IEP and 504 accommodations will be met as they relate to the learning model being utilized in each plan.</li><li>• Chromebooks will be available for students.
